- Take environmental factors into consideration in any new development or contract works
- Improve the environmental impact of the company's activities, specifically those caused through waste and transport
- Collect and monitor information regarding the environmental impact and record, including recording on the South East Carbon Hub online facilities
- Respond to the needs and concerns of the community promptly
- Priorities waste management by; Re-Use, Recycle, Energy Recovery, Disposal
- Reduce consumption of natural resources wherever possible
- Co-operate in any investigation concerning environmental impacts caused by the company
- Comply strictly with the Waste Disposal Policy
- Be pro-active in supporting the Government environmental initiatives along with WRAP'S Halving Waste to Landfill commitment
- Be aware of the COSHH Regulations 2002 (Amended 2004)
- Be aware of the Environment Protection Act 1990
- Work within all relevant Asbestos Regulations 2006 and ACOP procedures
